 - *All residents, staff, and visitors remain at risk for contracting COVID-19, regardless of individual vaccination status. Visitors will put their loved ones at risk when visiting under these guidelines. Holly Hall is not responsible should a visitor or resident become sick after visitation.*
 - *Violations to these policies and procedures could result in the loss of visiting privileges.*
1. Visitors must provide and wear their own facemask at all times while on property.
 2. Visitors must enter at the Administration Lobby and be scanned before entering the building.
 - a. After-hours visits (between 8:00 pm – 6:00 am) are to be reserved for end-of-life situations only. Visitors must enter the building and be screened at Healthcare.
 3. Up to four guests may visit at a time.
 4. Visitors are to remain in the resident's room at all times during the visit.
 5. There is no age limit for visitors, however we ask families to respect the tranquil environment on campus.
